EMBLEM

On a disc Air Force blue edged red, a naked dexter arm embowed in natural color, issuing from dexter base of disc, and holding upward in the head a futuristic red missile highlighted white, all outlines black. **SIGNIFICANCE:** The blue field of our emblem is the basic color of the Air Force, and signifies vigilance, perseverance, and justice. The Atlas like arm holding up a missile, symbolizes our strength and support, with support being our squadron's primary mission. The missile

symbolizes the type of support required. The bend around the disc indicates cooperation, unity, and efficiency. The color red, of the band and missiles, stands for our hardiness and valour.
