30 Jan 1982 The 601st Tactical Hospital at Sembach was inactivated and the function reverted to being a clinic.

Originally, the hospital designation was put into effect with the concept of Sembach's clinic being a 2nd echelon unit with an air transportable hospital. Though the concept had not changed, HQ USAFE decided the "hospital" classification was not required and the unit was inactivated effective 30 January 1982.
