The 603d Airlift Control Squadron deployed to Bangladesh in support of Operation Sea Angel after a devastating typhoon in May 1991. In all, five million pounds of relief supplies were trans-shipped to forward staging areas.

The 603d Airlift Control Squadron deployed to NAS Cubi Point, Republic of the Philippines in June 1991, after the eruption of Mount Pinatubo resulted in the evacuation of Clark AB. The 603d was responsible for the initial setup of airlift support which would aid in the evacuation of military personnel and their dependents.
