MISSION

The squadron maintains 32 McDonnell-Douglas KC-10A "Extender" aircraft. With over 450 active duty and air reserve technician personnel assigned, it is the largest squadron in the 305th Air Mobility Wing. The 605th AMXS supports two active duty and two Air Force Reserve air refueling squadrons and is often tasked to deploy in support of worldwide contingency operations on a moments' notice. Peacetime activities include daily training missions, distinguished visitor missions, and numerous off-station air refueling and airlift missions. The special missions section supports numerous Department of Defense, State Department, and other highly sensitive missions worldwide.
