Constituted in the Organized Reserve 1 October 1933, assigned to the 520th Air Depot, and allotted to the Sixth Corps Area. Chicago, IL, designated as headquarters on organization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Consolidated on 12 December 1936 with the 609th Aero Squadron (Supply) (a WWI unit organized in January 1918 at Kelly Field, TX; demobilized in September 1919 at Mitchel Field, NY; reconstituted on 12 December 1936). Disbanded 31 May 42.
