Constituted in the Organized Reserve 1 October 1933, assigned to the 518th Air Depot, and allotted to the Fourth Corps Area. Atlanta, GA, designated as headquarters on organization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Withdrawn from the Fourth Corps Area 5 June 1936 and allotted to the Second Corps Area. Mitchel Field, NY, designated as headquarters on organization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Consolidated on 7 December 1936 with the 610th Aero Squadron (Supply) (a WWI unit organized in January 1918 at Kelly Field, TX; demobilized in March 1919 at Middletown, PA; reconstituted on 7 December 1936). Disbanded 31 May 42.
