613th Supply Squadron Constituted in the Organized Reserve 1 October 1933, assigned to the 806th Air Depot, and allotted to the Eighth Corps Area. Initiated 20 June 1935 in the Eighth Corps Area. Withdrawn from the Eighth Corps Area 5 June 1936 and allotted to the Second Corps Area. Mitchel Field, NY, designated as headquarters on organization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Consolidated on 30 November 1936 with the 613th Aero Squadron (Supply) (a WWI unit organized in January 1918 at Kelly Field, TX; demobilized in January 1919 at Garden City, NY; reconstituted on 30 November 1936) Disbanded 31 May 42.
