Red Cliff, Newfoundland An Air Defense Control Centre (N-22A) was set on the White Hills at Pepperrell AFB St.John's, Newfoundland for Headquarters 64th Air Division (Defense). It was activated on 8 April 1952, and became operational in June 1954. Also at Red Cliff was the Air Defense Direction Centre (N-22) manned by personnel of the 642nd AC&W Squadron. Prior to being redesignated on 1 August 1953, the unit had been the 108th AC&W Squadron. It became operational by mid 1954. Red Cliff was phased out 1 October 1961
