Constituted in the Organized Reserve 1 October 1933, assigned to the 394th Air Depot, and allotted to the Second Corps Area. Buffalo, NY, designated as headquarters on organization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Consolidated on 3 December 1936 with the 653rd Aero Squadron (Supply) (a WWI unit organized in September 1917 as the 134th Aero Squadron (Supply) September 1917 at Kelly Field, TX; redesignated as the 653rd Aero Squadron (Supply) February 1918; demobilized in December 1918 at Camp Morrison, VA; reconstituted on 3 December 1936). Disbanded 31 May 42.
