MISSION

The 654 Combat Logistics Support Squadron is a primary Air Force Materiel Command forward deployed combat force providing 56 Expeditionary Depot Maintenance personnel for worldwide depot level maintenance and battle damage repair activities. We also support maintenance and modification for the Oklahoma City Air Logistics Center and B-1, B-2, B-52, E-3 and C/KC-135 aircraft systems.

These capabilities coupled with our combat training enable us to deploy within 24 hours to support the warfighter wherever and whenever called upon. The 654th Combat Logistics Support Squadron is a force multiplier for Maintenance Group commanders and the OC-ALC aircraft production lines. The 56 assigned maintainers average 21,690 man-hours of Depot Field Team "on-the-road" maintenance per year and contribute another 650 man-hours per month to the production depot maintenance line.
