Constituted in the Organized Reserve 1 October 1933, assigned to the 519th Air Depot, and allotted to the Fifth Corps Area. Indianapolis, IN, designated as headquarters on organization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Consolidated on 4 December 1936 with the 657th Aero Squadron (Supply) (a WWI unit organized in December 1917 as the 231st Aero Squadron (Supply) at Kelly Field, TX; redesignated as the 657th Aero Squadron (Supply) February 1918; demobilized in March 1919 at Garden City, NY; reconstituted on 4 December 1936). Disbanded 31 May 42.
