658th Repair Squadron (520th Air Depot) Organized Reserve Illinois
HQ-Not initiated 1933-41

Constituted in the Organized Reserve 1 October 1933, assigned to the 520th Air Depot, and allotted to the Sixth Corps Area. Chicago, IL, designated as headquarters on organization, but the unit was never organized at that location. Consolidated on 4 December 1936 with the 658th Aero Squadron (Supply) (a WWI unit organized in December 1917 as the 232nd Aero Squadron (Supply) at Kelly Field, TX; redesignated as the 658th Aero Squadron (Supply) February 1918; demobilized in May 19 at Mitchel Field, NY; reconstituted on 4 December 1936). Location 7 December 1941— Not initiated.

Status: Disbanded 31 May 42.
