1 Jun 88 Sixty-Seventh Aerospace Rescue and Recovery Squadron was redesignated 67th Special Operations Squadron, and 667th Consolidated Aircraft Maintenance Squadron (CAMS) was activated at RAF Woodbridge, United Kingdom.

14 Jan 89 Element of the 21st Special Operations Squadron, 67th Special Operations Squadron, 56th Aerospace Rescue and Recovery Squadron, and 1730<sup>th</sup> Pararescue Squadron, together with maintenance support from 667th Consolidated Aircraft Maintenance Squadron, rescued 32 persons from a distressed Cypriot cargo vessel, located 360 nautical miles northwest of Shannon, Ireland.
