This May day will long be remembered by these troops for they had spent the early part of the bitter winter in cold, bleak

Camp Grant, Illinois, being transferred from there to Kelly Field before being ordered here. A day or two later they received their first pay in months and lost no time learning the in's and out's of Belleville. However, they soon adapted themselves to their new surroundings and became an integral working part in upholding the standards of Scott Field. Changed in July to Squadron "C," which it still retains.
