OPERATIONS

This Navy AN/FPS-37 radar was added to the Air Defense Command network in 1962 at the time of the Cuban missile crisis. In June 1962 the 671st Radar Squadron (SAGE) was activated here. By 1966 an AN/FPS-67B was performing the sky search duties and would remain in operation for the next thirty years. In 1979 the Key West site became a TAC facility.

671st Radar Sq: activated 1 Jun 62 at Key West NAS, FL, assigned to MOADS; redesignated 671st Radar Sq (SAGE) 15 Jun 65; reassigned to 32nd AD 1 Apr 66; reassigned to 33rd AD 14 Nov 69; reassigned to 20th AD 19 Nov 69; redesignated 671 Radar Sq 1 Feb 74.
