OPERATIONS

AIA Mission Directive 1505 (23 March 1998) defined the 690th IOG mission.

Conduct information operations to support commanders within the USAF and other DoD agencies

Provide communications and computer services to support AIA headquarters
Provide information operations and C4I systems technical support and services to AIA and its subordinate units, national agencies, DoD agencies and operations commanders.

Responsibilities included: operating the Air Force Information Warfare Center, providing USAF Information Warfare indications and warning indicators, operating and maintaining C4I systems supporting AIA HQ, and conducting security certification and accreditation of classified communications and computer systems around the world. The 690th IOG reported to the 67th Intelligence Wing. At the dawn of the 21st Century, the Air Intelligence Agency reorganized,

creating an organizational structure that placed information operations on a par with its signals intelligence mission.
