OPERATIONS 697 Pyote AFS, TX FPS-3; FPS-6 1958 30-Jun-63Collocated with former bomber base. Following the deactivation of the site, base housing was taken over by the West Texas Children's Home, and the land and remaining buildings reverted to the University of Texas.

In 1958 the 697th AC&W Squadron began operating an AN/FPS-3 search radar and an AN/FPS-6 height-finder radar at this site. In March 1963 the Air Force ordered the site to close. Operations ceased on 1 August 1963.

697th AC&W Squadron: activated on 8 Dec 56 at Kirtland AFB, NM, as the 34th Air Division; moved to Pyote AFS, TX on 21 Feb 57; transferred to Albuquerque ADS 1 Jan 60; transferred to Oklahoma City ADS 15 Sep 60; transferred to 4752nd Air Defense Wing 1 Sep 61; transferred to Oklahoma City ADS 25 Jun 63; discontinued on 1. Aug 63.

In 1958 the 697th AC&W Squadron began operating AN/FPS-3 and AN/FPS-6 radars at this site. In March 1963 the Air Force ordered the site to close. Operation ceased a month later.
