698 Thomasville AFS, AL FPS-35; FPS-90 FPS-35; FPS-90 (2) late 1959 31-Dec-69 FPS-35 at this site was the prototype.

This site became operational in late 1959 when a test model of the AN/FPS-35 was installed for evaluation. This unit became permanent in the 1960s. Two AN/FPS-90 height-finder radars were added in the early 1960s. The assigned radar squadron, the 698th, was inactivated in December 1969.

698th Radar Sq (SAGE): activated Dec 57 at Dobbins AFB, GA, assigned to 35-t1T-AD; moved to Thomasville AFS, AL by Sep 58; transferred to 32nd AD 15 Nov 58; redesignated from AC&W Sq to. 698th Radar Sq (SAGE) 1 Oct 59; transferred to Montgomery ADS 1 Nov 59; reasigned to 32nd AD 1 Apr 66; inactivated 31 Dec 69.
