MISSION

The ASOC's primary responsibility is to provide the Army's III Corps the capability to receive and process requests for immediate Close Air Support, CAS, help facilitate the integration of CAS missions into the Ground Commander's scheme of maneuver, and advise the III Corps Staff on overall aerospace power employment.

When conducting combat operations we transition from the 712 ASOS (Air Support Operations Squadron) to the 712 ASOC (Air Support Operations Center). We establish connectivity with our higher headquarters AF Air Operations Center, and initiate and control the local Air Force Air Request Net, AFARN.

The 712 ASOS is a worldwide deployable mobility squadron; we have approximately 89 personnel, 12 officers and 77 enlisted. The squadron consists of several flights that are aligned under DO, LG, and SC. The DO flight consists of: DOE - Tactical Air Control Party (TACP), otherwise known as ROMADS, DOI - Intelligence, DO - Current Operations (Scheduling and Training), and DOX - Plans and Mobility. The LG flight consists of: SCS - Job Control, LGM - Material Control, LGV - Vehicle Maintenance, LGH - HVAC, and LGP - Power Production. The Transmissions flight consists of: Ground Radio Maintenance, Wideband/ Satellite Communications, and Communications Systems (Computer/Network, Switching and Crypto Systems and Control, Communications, and Computers).
