## **MISSION**

Serves as single focal point for cradle-to-grave sustainment management for the C-5 to sustain mission effectiveness throughout the system's life cycle. Responsible for all sustainment activities required to ensure C-5 availability is adequate for the weapon system to fulfill its assigned missions. Primary activities include engineering, worldwide logistics, weapon system readiness, and wartime support. Manages aircraft overhaul, modernization and modification programs, and unscheduled depot level maintenance for the C-5. Serves as the C-17 system support manager principal agent for all weapon system sustainment activities. This includes government furnished equipment sustainment spares as well as depot partnering with prime contractor sustainment activities.
