## **MISSION**

Provides Automatic Test Sustainment for our nation's war fighters. Manages and maintains Automatic Test Systems (ATS) over their lifecycle. Responsible for identification, acquisition support, and sustainment of all Air Force common ATS and Test, Measurement, and Diagnostic Equipment (TMDE) supporting USAF, joint services, FMS, and U.S. coalition customers. Manages 21,312 spares NSNs.

Programs include: Automatic Test Systems and Test Measurement and Diagnostic Equipment for combat and mobility aircraft and munitions. Directly supports F-15,A-10, E-3A, B-1B, B-2, B-52, C-17, C-5, Cruise Missile, and many other common weapon/test systems (i.e., Common Munitions Bit Reprogramming Equipment (CMBRE), Bench top Reconfigurable Automatic Tester (BRAT), and Common Organizational Level Tester (COLT)).
