755th Radar Sq (SAGE): assigned 1 Jan 51 at Elkhorn, WI, assigned to the 541st ACW Gp; transferred to 30th AD 6 Feb 52; transferred to 4706th Def Wg 16 Feb 53; site redesignated to Williams Bay AFS, WI 1 Dec 53; transferred to 37th AD 8 Jul 56; transferred to 30th AD 1 Apr 59;' transferred to Chicago ADS 1 Jun 59; moved to Arlington Heights, IL 1 Apr. 60; redesignated from ACCIW Sq to 755<sup>th</sup> Radar Sq (SAGE) 15 Oct 60; transferred to 20th AD 1 Apr 66; reassigned to 30th AD 1 Dec 67; reassigned to 34th AD 1 Jul 68; inactivated 30 Sep 69.

### **ILLINOIS** Arlington Heights

This radar site and attendant squadron was moved to this location from Williams Bay, Wisconsin (LP-31/P-31) and activated in 1961 with AN/FPS-20A, AN/FPS-6, and AN/FPS-6B radars. The AN/FPS-20 was upgraded to an AN/FPS-67 during the following year. Also in 1962 the site began SAGE operations. In 1963 an AN/FPS-90 had replaced the AN/FPS-6B for performing height-finding duties. The 755th Radar Squadron was deactivated in September 1969.

## WISCONSIN, Elk Horn, Williams Bay

In late 1951 the 755th AC&W Squadron began operating a pair of AN/CPS-6B radars. An AN/FPS-6 height-finder radar was added in 1959. This station ceased operations in January 1960 and was reactivated as a gap-filler site, supporting the P-31 site at Arlington Heights, Illinois.

755 Williams Bay AFS, WI CPS-6B (2); FPS-6 late 1951 30-Jun-60 Sq relocated to RP-31, Arlington Heights AI, IL; William Bay AFS became gap-filler site RP-31F (SW corner of site).

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height-finder radar was added in 1959. This station ceased operations in January 1960 when the 755th Radar Squadron relocated to the Army radar site at Arlington Heights, IL (MM-4). Williams Bay AFS itself was reactivated as a gap-filler site, supporting the radar site at Arlington Heights (RP-31/Z-31).

755Arlington Heights AI, ILFPS-20 / FPS-67; FPS-6; FPS-6B / FPS-90FPS-67B; FPS-6;FPS-90196130-Sep-69Squadron relocated from Williams Bay AFS, WI (P-31). Shared Armyradar site for the Nike missile-defense system (C-80DC); Missile Master site MM-4.

The 755th AC&W Squadron was moved to this US Army Nike radar site (C-80DC) from Williams Bay AFS, Wisconsin (LP-31/P-31) and activated in 1961 with AN/FPS-20A, AN/FPS-6, and AN/FPS-6B radars. The AN/FPS-20 was upgraded to an AN/FPS-67 during the following year. Also in 1962 the site began SAGE operations. In 1963 an AN/FPS-90 had replaced the AN/FPS-6B for performing height-finding duties. The AN/FPS-67 was upgraded to an AN/FPS-67 was upgraded to an AN/FPS-67B in 1966. The 755th Radar Squadron was deactivated in September 1969.
