EMBLEM

On a disc Sable, in chief stylized White crow eyes, with outlines and pupils Black, fimbriated Gray and frown lines of the same, issuing from either side of the disc a wing tip Black, sleeved Gray, resting on top of a crystal ball Azure, charged with three lightning bolts points downward and all meeting at base Or, all above six mullets following baseline Gules, all within a narrow border Red. Attached above the disc, a Black scroll edged with a narrow Red border and inscribed "EX LUCE AD UMBRAS"" in Red letters. Attached below the disc, a Black scroll edged with a narrow Red border and inscribed "771ST TEST SQUADRON" in Red letters. SIGNIFICANCE: Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The silhouetted eyes and wings of the crow masked in shadow represent wisdom and stealth. The crystal ball represents the world and the unit's effort to leverage technology to improve Electronic Warfare capabilities. The six stars represent the original Combined Test Forces that the unit supports. (Approved, 2 Mar 2007)
