EMBLEM

On a disc Azure, between the wings of a globe Argent, edged and gridlined Sable, charged with a contrail arcing from sinister base to dexter chief Gules, terminating in a delta Argent (Silver Gray), winged Or, in chief two battle-axes in saltire, handles of the fourth and striped at grips of the third, axe heads of the fifth, all within a narrow Yellow border. Attached above the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "VERUM QUOD FIDELITAS" in Yellow letters. Attached below the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "802D COMPTROLLER SQ" in Yellow letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The "winged globe" represents the dedication and swiftness of the Squadron's ability to accomplish its mission and soar above the rest in the greatest Air Force in the world. The stylized aircraft in flight represents the Squadron's ability to provide global support for missions abroad. The axes represent the execution of military duty and determination to always exceed.
