Per chevron celeste and gules issuing from base a sphere of the first with axis palewise, rimmed and gridlined sable with land masses of the like surmounted by two arced olive branches saltirewise vert with berries of the second below in pale a sword with blade to base argent garnished of the third, hilt of the second within four lightning flashes saltirewise or all within a diminished bordure of the last. (Approved, 9 may 1958) (Revised, Apr 1982)

OPERATIONS

The division supervised, managed, and trained tactical and support forces of the Ninth Air Force, Sep 1957-Jul 1961. It deployed subordinate units to Southeast Asia for combat operations between 1962 and 1965, 1967 and 1971, 1972, and again in 1973. During 1965-1970, some subordinate units functioned as replacement training units for F-4 aircrews. In 1968 the division began supervising B-57 light bomber aircrew training, and between 1967 and 1971, it supervised tests for weapon systems, aircraft armament and munitions, and tactical procedures. From Jan 1981, it advised Air Force component commanders and land forces on A-10 aircraft tactics, training, employment and readiness, and subordinate units participated in exercises such as Red Flag and Celtic Echo.
