864th AC6W Squadron: activated 8 Aug 55 at Yuma City Airport, AZ, as the 27th Air Division; redesignated Vincent AFB, AZ in Sep 56; transferred to Los Angeles ADS on 1 Oct 59; transferred to Phoenix ADS on I_May 61; site redesignated to Yuma AFS, AZ in mid-1960, redesignated to 864th Radar Squadron (SAGE) on 1 Jun 62; redesignation as Radar Squadron (SAGE) revoked by SO G-4, 15 Oct 62; discontinued 1 Aug 63.

The 864th AC&W Squadron began operations in 1956. In March 1963 the Air Force ordered the site and its AN/MPS-7 and AN/MPS-14 radars to shut down. Operations ceased on April 30.
