Constituted in the Organized Reserve on 20 December 1928, assigned to the 64th Cavalry Division, and allotted to the Fifth Corps Area. Relieved on 21 February 1929 from assignment to the 64th Cavalry Division. Initiated by October 1931 at Akron, OH. Consolidated on 8 December 1936 with the 864th Aero Squadron (Depot) (a WWI unit organized in March 1918 at St. Paul, MN; demobilized in November 1919 at St. Paul; reconstituted on 8 December 1936). Inactivated by June 1937 at Akron by relief of personnel. Disbanded on 31 May 1942.
