On 21 April 1942, the Army Air Force was established 885th Military Police Company (Aviation) and assigned to the Army Air Forces Ferrying Command (which later became Air Transport Command). Then, on August 1942, the unit was redesignated the 885th Guard Squadron. Home base of operations was at the Wayne County Airport in Michigan. From that time until disbanding on 1 May 1944.
