OPERATIONS

The 901st CAM Squadron active duty for training for FY 70 was conducted during the period 22 September 1969. A two shift operation was utilized to support the scheduled flying activities of the 731st MAS. On 9 September the evacuation of five assigned C-124C aircraft was required due to the possibility of Hurricane Greta striking this area. Once notification was received that evacuation of assigned aircraft was required all efforts were expended to ready the aircraft for evacuation due to the limited hangar facilities at this station. A maintenance team of thirty maintenance technicians was formed to accompany the aircraft to their hurricane evacuation base for turnaround maintenance. All aircraft departed Hanscom and returned with no problems encountered. This accomplishment in addition to having successfully passed a 21st AF ORI three days previously while maintaining a 90.5% in-commission rate during the ORI reflects the high calibre of qualification of assigned personnel.
