EMBLEM

On a disc Azure, within a wreath banded in base Or, an eagle swooping to dexter Sable, detailed Argent, beak and talons of the second, claws Brun, grasping in its dexter claw a quill pen of the second, detailed of the third, and in its sinister claw a parchment of the fourth, detailed of the third; all within a narrow border Yellow. Attached above the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "EXCELLENCE THRU TEAMWORK" in Yellow letters. Attached below the disc, a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "902D CONTRACTING SQ" in Yellow letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The eagle shows the patriotism of the Squadron, and the contract in its talons represents how the United States requires contracting in order to continue to soar. The parchment and quill symbolize contractual involvement the unit provides in direct support to its parent unit and its mission to train and educate personnel as a ready force to defend the peace. The wreath symbolizes the perseverance and dedication of the personnel in the Squadron. (Approved, 25 May 2010)
