## **OPERATIONS**

904th Radar Sq (SAGE): activated 18 Jun 53 at Kirtland AFB, NM, assigned to 34TTI—AD; moved to Winslow AFS, AZ in spring of 55; transferred to LA ADS 1 Jan 60; transferred to Phoenix ADS 1 May 61; redesignated from AC6W Sq to 904th Radar Sq (SAGE) 15 Oct 61; discontinued 1 Aug 63.

Winslow became operational in 1956 with the 904th AC&W Squadron using an AN/MPS-11 radar. In 1958 an AN/FPS-6A height-finder radar was added. In March 1963 the Air Force ordered Winslow closed; operations ceased on April 30.
