On a disc Vert, issuing from base a pair of hands with wrists conjoined opened fesswise fingers upward Proper, supporting a column of water palewise throughout Azure (Light Blue), and spattering Gutté-d' eau (Dark Blue), surmounted in chief by three mullets in fess Or, all within a narrow border Black. Attached below the disc, an Emerald scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "914TH SERVICES SQ" in Black letters. **SIGNIFICANCE**: Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The yellow stars are representative of Air Force core competencies. The reaching hands reflect mission support and care of skilled unit members.
