OPERATIONS

Dispensary accomplished 365 medical examinations, 607 dental examinations, 349 audiograms, 334 X-rays, 524 immunizations and 161 electrocardiograms. The Dispensary conducted inspections in Occupational Medicine and Sanitary and Industrial Hygiene. The general health of flying personnel remained excellent. The 21st Air Force advisory staff team that inspected the Group's dispensary 6-9 February summarized their findings with this comment: "The 915 USAF Dispensary is providing excellent medical support to the Military Airlift Group. The facility accomplishes an average of 100 physicals and 120 immunizations for each unit training assembly. The unit is 102 percent manned with two overages consisting of medical airmen, and one shortage consisting of a medical officer." They concluded that "the management and control of health records was excellent.
