EMBLEM



On a disc Azure, in front of a lighthouse displaying alternating stripes in bend Argent and Sable, the top in chief lighted Or, a highway bendwise sinister in prospect Grebe, thereon a broken centerline of the fourth supporting the "Prime Beef" bull Proper incensed White. In dexter flank, a trail of five Yellow mullets arching to chief and diminishing in size as they go upward, all within a narrow border Black. Attached above the disc, a White scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "EXCELLENCE IN ENGINEERING" in Black letters. Attached below the disc, a White scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "916TH CIVIL ENGINEER SQ" in Black letters. SIGNIFICANCE: Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue

alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the
excellence required of Air Force personnel. The stylized bull is the traditional symbol for Air Force
engineering units. Approved on 26 Jul 2004.
