922 Squadron: activated 26 May 53 at Grenier AFB, NH, as the 4707th Defense Wing; transfer to NEAC in fall of 53; reassigned to ADC and 4732nd Air Defense Group on 1 Apr 57; transferred to Goose ADS on 1 Apr 60; transferred to 37th Air Division on 1 Apr 66; discontinued on 18 Jun 68.
