EMBLEM



Per bend Gules and Azure a lightning flash bendwise Or overall a top hat bendwise Sable shaded Silver Gray highlighted Argent issuing a demi-pegasus of the last fimbriated and detailed Black; all within a diminished bordure of the last. Attached above the disc a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Black border. Attached below the disc a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed II JUST MAGIC II in Black letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Blue and yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The Pegasus represents the squadron's parent organization and its flying mission. The top hat symbolizes the unit and its maintenance taskings to support that mission. The lightning flash denotes the expediency with which the squadron performs its services. (Approved, 22 May 1996)
