### EMBLEM



927 Consolidated Aircraft Maintenance Squadron emblem: On an ultramarine azure disc, a vert entwined leaf is Shaped into a wreath and positioned at dexter chief. The Wreaths urmountsa gules wrench Iso positioned diagonally at Dexter chief. A vert globe highlighted with argent longitude And latitude lines is placed at sinister base. Five or Estoilles extend from between middle chief and sinister chief To dexter. Three or contrails issuant the estoilles Positioned from the fess point to dexter and proceed beneath The globe to sinister, where they converge at a single point. The disc is bordered with or. Two argent scrolls are attached Above and below the disc. The scrolls are also bordered with or. The scrolls are blank and reserved for the unit's designation. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and air force yellow are used in the design. Blue represents the sky, the primary theater of air Force operations. Yellow signifies the sun and the excellence Required of air force personnel. The wreath represents the Designated air craft maintenance qualifications badge that Identifies and recognizes superior levels of skill. The Wrench symbolizes the capability of 927th personnel to use Those skills and knowledge to accomplish their mission even Under adverse situations. The color red distinguishes air Force

personnel's conviction and perseverance toward mission accomplishment. The globe represents the 927th's capability to respond to worldwide situations. The stars represent the essential characteristics of air force maintenance personnel: professionalism, leadership, integrity, pride and loyalty. The three joining stars of professionalism, leadership and integrity reflect the very core of air force success in all mission assignments. The emblem as a whole reflects the genuine dedication and exemplary accomplishments this unit contributes to its nation. (Approved, 30 Mar 1992)
