On a disc per chevron Celeste and Gules, a chevron Sable between a scroll Or detailed of the third surmounted by a quill pen Azure in base and an abstract aircraft Or detailed of the third in chief, all within a narrow border Blue. Attached below the disc, a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Blue border and inscribed "931ST MAINT OPS FLT" in Blue letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The light blue field represents the sky. The golden stylized aircraft symbolizes the excellent support provided by 931st Maintenance Operations Flight to the aerospace vehicles under its care. The black chevron signifies protection, faithful service and determination. The red background represents military strength, courage and patriotism.
