On a disc Celeste, in chief three mullets Or, between in saltire a wrench bendwise Argent and issuant from sinister base a screwdriver shank of the last, handle of the second; a bordure gyronny Argent and Azure, all within a narrow Blue border. Attached beneath the disc, a Yellow scroll with a narrow blue border and inscribed "931ST MAINTENANCE SQ" in Blue letters. SIGNIFICANCE: Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The alternating blue and white identifies the Squadron as part of the 931st Maintenance Group. Three yellow stars symbolize the core values of the Air Force: excellence in all we do, integrity, and service before self. The crossed white screwdriver and wrench represent the tools required to achieve perfection in all tasks.
