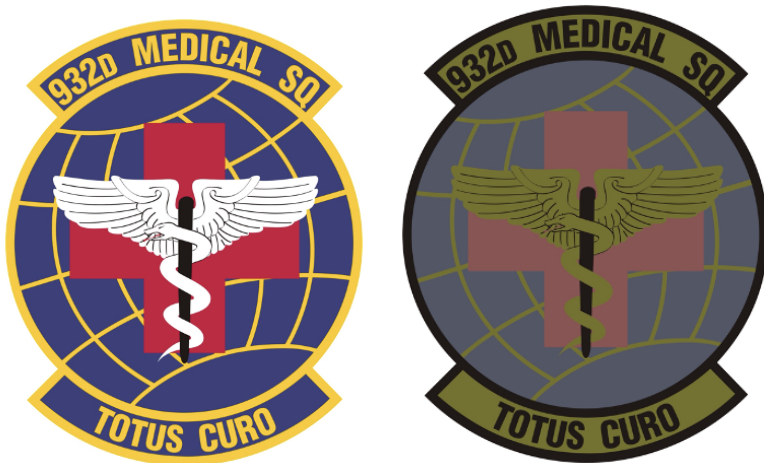

EMBLEM



Azure as a globe gridlines on an axis bendwise Or a cross couped Gules surmounted by a staff of Aesculapius, staff Sable serpent Argent, langued of the third eyed Black winged fesswise White, all within a diminished bordure Yellow. Attached above the disc an Azure scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "9320 MEDICAL SQ" in Yellow letters. Attached below the disc an Azure scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "TOTUS CURO" in Yellow letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Blue and yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The globe represents the unit's global mission. The red cross signifies the squadron's medical function it's personnel's perseverance and commitment to provide the best medical care. The staff of Aesculapius suggests rapid medical response anywhere in the world. (Approved, 26 Apr 2000)
