EMBLEM



On a disc as a globe Azure, gridlined Argent, Viking helmet Purpure, detailed Or, riveted Sable, armed of the second; in chief nautical star of the fourth, faceted of the third; all within a narrow Yellow Border. Above the disc a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "SUPPORTING THE FORCE" in Yellow letters. Below the disc a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "934TH LOGISTICS READINESS SQ" in Yellow letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The globe represents the unit's worldwide capabilities. The helmet signifies the unit's warrior heritage. The nautical star always leads in the right directions. Nine rivets on the helmet represent the nine Air Force Specialty Codes in Logistics Readiness Squadron and strength. (Approved, 3 Sep 2009)

OPERATIONS

In CY 2020 the Logistics Readiness Squadron helped to close out the Wing's major redeployment from CENTCOM as a part of their Reserve Component Period (RCP). Their successes during this overall effort was the deployment of over one third of the Wing, achieving 98% overall in deployment metrics: 661Airmen, 91.6 tons of cargo assigned to the Wing which enabled 8 Air and Space Expeditionary Force (AEF) Operations across 17 countries. For their efforts, the LRS was awarded the AFRC Logistics Readiness and Maintenance Award for LRS Quality Assurance, in May 2020. A notable project focused on the Installation, that LRS had a hand in, was the work towards completing a new Military Gas Station.
