EMBLEM



Azure, a globe on axis bendwise Silver Gray with axis points Argent (White) and longitudinal lines Sable, orbited clockwise by a Viking long boat in trian-aspect with oars and mast Proper, orbital path of the Third, the sail hoisted of the like charged with nine mullets on bend three, four and two Or, orbiting counter-clockwise above, a flight symbol ascending to sinister Brown, all within a diminished bordure of the Fifth. Attached above the disc a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "934TH LOGISTICS SUPPORT SQ" in Yellow letters. Attached below the disc a Blue scroll edged with a narrow Yellow border and inscribed "SUPPORTING THE WORLD" in Yellow letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Blue and yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The globe signifies the global extent of the unit's mission. The long boat and delta symbol alludes to the units past service and it's future support. The nine stars on the sail represent the unit's navigational skills and refer to the unit's original emblem. (Approved, 30 Aug 2000)
