## OPERATIONS

On 1 January, the 938th Consolidated Maintenance Squadron was inactivated and replaced by its four component squadrons. These were the 938th Avionics Maintenance Squadron, the 938th Field Maintenance Squadron, and the 938th Organizational Maintenance Squadron servicing C-141s, and the 945th Organizational Maintenance Squadron servicing C-5s. Then, effective 1 July,

all 938th designations were changed to 349th designations (e.g., 349th Avionics Maintenance Squadron). In addition to these squadrons, the 349th Military Airlift Wing included a civil engineering squadron, an air base squadron, and a medical services squadron. All of them augmented their active duty counterparts at Travis and assisted with reservist training.
