Vert gridlined as a globe Or, three annulets fretty per triangle Sanguine in dexter chief a flight symbol volant to dexter issuing a contrail arcing and diminishing in sinister chief Sable; all within a diminished bordure Azure. Attached below the disc a Yellow scroll edged with a narrow Blue border and inscribed "939TH LOGISTICS SUPPORT SQ" in Blue letters. **SIGNIFICANCE:** Yellow is an Air Force color. It refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The flight symbol, encircling the globe, represents the unit's support of and participation in worldwide Air Force mission requirements. The interlocking rings symbolize the teamwork necessary for the three Logistics branches - Staff, Supply and Transportation - to provide quality logistics support. (Approved, 3 Jun 1998)
