

940 MISSION SUPPORT GROUP



MISSION

The 940 Mission Support Group directs and integrates the activities of four subordinate units, each with their own unique mission, to provide infrastructure and support functions in eleven distinct functional areas, both in garrison and while deployed, to enable the 940 Wing to provide oversight of command and control, intelligence, surveillance and high altitude reconnaissance missions. In addition, the 940 Mission Support Group supports the wing's geographically-separated units at March Air Reserve Base, California; Joint Base Langley-Eustis, Virginia; and Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam, Hawaii.

Approximately 390 Reservists are assigned to the 940th Mission Support Group, about one third of the 940th Wing's total manning. Of these, 22 are full-time Air Reserve Technicians, five are full-time civilians, and two are Active Guard Reserve; the rest of the team is composed of Traditional Reservists.
