On a disc per bend Azure and Gules, a roaring winged lion salient Argent, detailed Sable, within an annulet of sixteen mullets Or; all within a narrow border Black. Attached above the disk, a White scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "SEMPER ILLIC" in Black letters. Attached below the disk, a White scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "943D MSF" in Black letters. **SIGNIFICANCE** Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The winged lion symbolizes fierceness and strength within the skies. The stars represent military power and glory. The unit's Latin motto "SEMPER ILLIC" means "Always There" in English.
