EMBLEM



On a disc Azure, an American Bald Eagle Volant Proper, grasping in both talons a lightning bolt bendwise Or, above and in front of three Ionic columns Argent, detailed Silver Gray, all within a narrow bordure Black. Attached above the disc, a White scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "ONE MISSION TOTAL FORCE" in Black letters. Attached below the disc, a White scroll edged with a narrow Black border and inscribed "951ST RESERVE SUPPORT SQ" in Black letters. SIGNIFICANCE: Ultramarine blue and Air Force yellow are the Air Force colors. Blue alludes to the sky, the primary theater of Air Force operations. Yellow refers to the sun and the excellence required of Air Force personnel. The American Bald Eagle is our nation symbol. The three columns symbolize the three types of personnel assigned and supported. The lightning bolt represents the wartime mission of the unit. (Approved, 21 Jun 2004)
