Organization was a Regular Army Inactive unit assigned to the General Headquarters Reserve and allotted to the Eighth Corps Area.

Organized on 16 May 28 with Organized Reserve personnel as a Regular Army Inactive unit at Waco, TX. Designated mobilization training station was Dodd Field, Fort Sam Houston, TX, 1927-33 and Waco Field, TX 1933-41.

Conducted annual summer training at Kelly Field, TX.

Withdrawn from the Eighth Corps Area 5 Jun 1936 and allotted to the Sixth Corps Area.

Chicago, IL, designated as headquarters on reorganization, but the unit was never organized at that location.
