11/12/2010 The landscape of the 1st Fighter Wing's corps of maintainers changed as the 1 Component Maintenance Squadron inactivated and the 1 Equipment Maintenance Squadron was re-designated as the 1st Maintenance Squadron in a historic ceremony at the 149<sup>th</sup> Fighter Squadron hangar, Oct. 29. The Airmen of the two squadrons merged together to form the large new squadron, nicknamed the "Dragons." Along with the inactivation and re-designation came a change of command as Lt. Col. Jason Gibson, former 1st Equipment Maintenance Squadron commander, relinquished command of the renamed unit to Maj. Elizabeth Boehm, the last commander of the 1st Component Maintenance Squadron prior to its inactivation. Col. George Zaniewski, commander of the 1st Maintenance Group, praised the steadfastness of Colonel Gibson in the face of "tumultuous times" at Langley, bringing to light the squadron's accomplishments under his command. "
