### MISSION

The 1st Medical Support Squadron mission is providing health support for the full range of military deployments and sustaining the health of members of the Armed Forces, their families, and others to advance our national security interests. Administrative and ancillary departments support a 35-bed hospital with an annual patient base of 400,000. Resource managers execute a \$24-million budget. The 1 Medical Support Squadron also maintains logistical support for 60 sections and 25-bed Expeditionary Medical Support asset and manages TRICARE-Department of Defense managed health care plan.
